Requirements: Grades 9-12

Students must have Windows Movie Maker (standard with Windows XP) or iMovie (standard with Mac OS X), a compatible FireWire (IEEE 1394) capable video camcorder, and a compatible computer with FireWire video capture. Students also need a CD or DVD writer for submitting larger assignment files via mail.
